2. There were four U18C teams.
3. Significant Victories:
 - Team officials from each team told me they had a great seasons off-ice and were pleased with the camaraderie developed in each of their teams;
 - So many great parents and kids stepped up both officially as managers, coaches, tournament volunteers, and team officials as well as unofficially around the rink. Great thanks to all involved in the hockey community for all the time and effort they dedicated to the division.
 - Every team had on-ice success with all four teams qualifying for tournament finals during the season; and
 - U18C1 won the blue (top) division playoff banner; U18C3 won the League banner; U18C2 and U18C3 won tournaments during the year.
4. Challenges:
 - Player safety - kids were getting injured more than we wanted due to hits at the house level. In response, we organized training, for both players and coaches, related to how to safely compete at the house levels. This was seen as successful and will continue next year with taking the coaches feedback into consideration;
 - There were some challenges related to discipline - to the amount of penalty minutes and types of penalties. No team in U18C across all of PCAHA FVN won a sportsmanship award. The previously mentioned training should help with this and we hope to work with the other cities within FVN as this will be needed to drive real change in this area;
 - Issues related to team formation and effort from players during evaluations. Working on solutions for this.
