

This year Coquitlam had 3 rep teams at the U13A level. A recap of each of their seasons –

### **U13A1**

U13A1 had a great season, filled with strong challenges which helped to further develop their hockey skills. Coaches Ryan Dorohoy & Billy MacGillivray were fully committed & monumental to the success of the team, pushing the boys to achieve their highest playing potential.

They started the regular season in Flight 2 and dominated the division, going 14-0 to the Christmas break!

After the Christmas break, they were moved up into Flight 1 for the remainder of the league play, where they went 4-3-1. This result shows the outstanding growth of the team from where they started at the beginning of the season – being able to hold their own against some of the best teams in the province for U13. After being knocked out in the 2<sup>nd</sup> round of the tier 1 playoffs, they finished the season in 8th place out of all the Flight 1 teams.

U13A1 took part in 4 tournaments including the highly coveted Vernon Coca-Cola Classic which parents and players said was the best tournament that they have ever been a part of.
