

CMHA EQUIPMENT AND DRESS CODE

The dress code outlines the standard of dress to which players and coaching staff are expected to adhere to while representing the Association and community in all league, playoff, tournament and exhibition games. Dress codes set a positive image for your Association, community and your team.

The primary objective of this policy is to promote unity throughout our hockey programs. We will endeavor to provide products that are competitively priced, and of good quality.

USE OF CMHA LOGO & BRANDING

- All additional use of CMHA branding or logos outside of the assigned apparel must be approved by the Board of Directors.
- Any team found to have purchased apparel or other items through a non approved supplier that utilizes any CMHA logo or branding or uses any other form of branding / logo shall be subject to a \$500 fine and a referral to the discipline committee. Said items will not be permitted for use and there shall be no reimbursement for any costs.

JERSEYS

- 1. No equipment or uniforms allocated to teams are to be used for non-CMHA functions.
- 2. All teams will only wear jerseys provided by CMHA or approved by CMHA Board of Directors.
- 3. Each player will submit two Jersey deposit cheques in the amount of \$200.00 each, post-dated to April 15th of the following calendar year. The Team Manager or designate will collect jersey deposit cheques once all players are placed on to their initial teams or groups. The Team Manager or designate will submit all cheques by



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October 15th to the CMHA Treasurer with the completed Team Equipment Form. Any player that does not provide jersey deposit cheques will be removed from participating in any hockey activity by the VP until the cheques are received. Also teams are responsible to write two jersey deposit cheques, for goalie jerseys each at \$200.00. Ensure you note the child's name and division in the memo area for all cheques.

- 4. A garment bag must be purchased by each player to hold their jerseys. At the time of collecting jersey deposits, players must show the team Manager that they have a garment bag before being issued a jersey.
- 5. Each player will be responsible for maintaining their jerseys throughout the season. ABSOLUTELY NO HEMMING OR ALTERING OF THE JERSEYS IS PERMITTED. Failure to return the jerseys in good condition at the end of each season will result in the deposit cheque being cashed. If returned in good condition within the time allowed, the deposit cheque will be destroyed.
 - "Good condition" is defined as no rips, tears, holes, or signs of mold.
 Game related jersey damage must be reported to the team equipment manager as it happens.
- 6. Jerseys are for game use only. They should not be used for team practices. Teams may wish to purchase practice jerseys from one of the CMHA Approved Suppliers.
- 7. Name bars cannot be added to the jerseys as they can cause significant damage. Teams may choose to purchase a 3rd jersey to have their name bars added. These jerseys must comply with CMHA branding guidelines and be purchased through one of the CMHA Approved Suppliers. Contact the CMHA Equipment Manager for additional information.
- 8. A's and C's are optional for U11 U21 and they can be added to the jerseys. The application of these letters often cause damage to the jersey by not using the right process when attaching them. Teams are responsible for purchasing the A's and C's from team fees if they choose to use them. Teams must purchase "non glue on" A's and C's. These letters must be attached using a loose zig zag stitch (see image) and must be removed before jersey return. Jerseys returned without the removal of the letters or that have been damaged, will result in their jersey





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GOALIE GEAR

CMHA will provide goalie gear for U7 - U9 & U11 C divisions to assist with the incorporation of the CMHA Positional Play policy. Teams are required to provide 2 goaltender gear deposit cheques in the amount of \$400.00, at the beginning of the season which will be returned upon return of the gear. Goalie gear for these divisions may also be available through Spring but must be requested via the CMHA Equipment Manager with a \$650.00 deposit cheque. Also teams are responsible to write two jersey deposit cheques, for goalie jerseys each at \$200.00

FIRST AID KITS

First aid kits are provided as a resource in case of minor injuries on or off the ice and will be issued to each team at the start of the season. First Aid kits must be replenished by the HCSP at the end of the season and returned with the team equipment.

PUCK BAGS

Puck bags, cones and pucks will be issued to each team at the start of the season. These items are to be returned in full at the end of the season.

EQUIPMENT DEPOSIT & RESPONSIBILITY

The Team Equipment Manager shall be responsible for collecting and allocating the equipment to Team Officials and players. The Team Equipment Manager shall ensure that all equipment is accounted for and returned to the CMHA Equipment Manager in appropriate condition at the end of each season. All puck bags and first aid kits must be replenished, A's and C's must be safely removed from the jerseys and jerseys must be inspected for damages and repaired prior to equipment return.

Each Team will be required to provide a deposit of \$300.00 for an equipment deposit. The Coach of each team is responsible for ensuring the proper care and return of all equipment as well as ensuring all CMHA policies are followed. The Coach may delegate this responsibility but ultimately is the individual accountable for their team.

REQUIRED EQUIPMENT FOR ALL PLAYERS

The current list of CMHA approved equipment required by each player is:

- Jerseys Home & Away (provided)
- Knit socks (provided)
- Black or Gold Helmet
 - o Game day dress code to be determined by the team. Note Coaches should follow the same dress code as their team or wear CMHA jacket with nice pants and shoes

U11A to U21A

- Jerseys Home & Away (provided)
- Socks (provided)
- Shorts/dry-fit shirt



• Gold Helmet

o Game day dress code - To be determined by the team - Typically tracksuit or dress suit. Note – Coaches should follow the same dress code as their team or wear CMHA jacket with nice pants and shoes

APPROVED SUPPLIERS

- As required, CMHA will provide our approved supplier(s) with various designs incorporating the CMHA logo.
- On an ongoing basis, CMHA will accept proposals from potential suppliers to become an approved supplier. Each proposal will be considered on its own merits.
- CMHA believes in supporting businesses in our community & will endeavor to create long-lasting relationships with local businesses.
- All CMHA teams wishing to purchase team apparel of any kind are required to purchase through our approved supplier(s). Teams violating this policy will be subject to a fine and a referral to the discipline committee.
